TODAY'S GAME

FLYERS at SABRES

-First of three meetings between the Sabres and Flyers this season

-Last meeting: Philadelphia defeated Buffalo, 2-1, in Buffalo on April 5

-The Sabres are 4-5-1 in their last 10 games vs. the Flyers; 3-5-2 at home

- This is the 158th game all-time between Buffalo and Philadelphia; Buffalo trails the series with a 61-74-23 record. Buffalo is 38-29-10 at home against the Flyers all-time.

STORYLINES

1. Buffalo opens the season at First Niagara Center for the first time in three years after dropping a 2-1 shootout decision to Montreal on Oct. 3, 2009. The Sabres opened 2011-12 in Helsinki, Finland, defeating Anaheim, 4-1, on Oct. 7, 2011.
2. The Sabres will look to rebound after suffering their fifth ever season sweep at the hands of the Flyers in 2011-12, going 0-3-1.
3. **Jason Pominville** leads all Sabres with 24 points (11+13) in 26 career games against the Flyers, including seven (3+4) in his last six.

OPENING NIGHT

-Tonight marks the 42nd season opener in Buffalo Sabres franchise history

-The Sabres are 23-14-4 in season openers all-time; 16-6-4 when opening at home

-Lindy Ruff is 8-5-1 (.607) in season openers as Buffalo's head coach

-Buffalo has opened against Philadelphia once in franchise history; the Flyers won 2-0 in Philadelphia on Oct. 9, 2004

THE BIG TWO

Only **Thomas Vanek** and **Ryan Miller** have played in all seven of Buffalo's season openers since the start of the 2005-06 season.

Miller has started all seven games and has a record of 5-1-1.

2011-12 SEASON RECAP

Buffalo was 39-32-11 last season, finishing ninth in the Eastern Conference, three points out of the final playoff spot... **Jason**

Pominville led the Sabres in scoring for the first time 73 points (30+43) in 82 games... **Ryan Miller** posted a career-best six shutouts and overtook Dominik Hasek for the franchise record in wins (252).

A FRESH FACE

At 18 years and 254 days old, **Mikhail Grigorenko** will become the sixth 18-year-old ever to dress for the Sabres on opening day. Only four players have suited up for the Sabres' first regular season game at a younger age: Pierre Turgeon (18 years-41 days), Tom Barrasso (18-188), Phil Housley (18-211) and Shawn Anderson (18-244). (Source: Elias Sports Bureau)

HOME ICE ADVANTAGE

Jason Pominville registered at least one point in 32 of 41 home games last season. His 46 home points (17+29) ranked him fifth in the NHL. **Pominville** hasn't been held pointless in consecutive home games since Feb. 25 and 26, 2011.

THOMAS THE TANK

Vanek finished last season with 11 points (3+8) in his last 10 games. **Vanek** recorded three points (2+1) in four games against the Flyers last season.

LET'S PLAY TWO

Tonight's game opens up Buffalo's first of nine sets of back-to-back games this season after the team had a league-high 21 sets last season. The Sabres finished last season 13-8-0 in the first game and 7-9-5 in the second. The Sabres' points breakdown in back-to-back sets was as follows: four points (4), three points (2), two points (10), one point (3) and zero points (2).

LINDY'S LONGEVITY

Since **Lindy Ruff** was named Buffalo's head coach on July 21, 1997, there have been 170 coaching changes in the NHL. **Ruff** is the second-longest tenured coach in the four major professional sports leagues. Only Gregg Popovich, who began coaching the San Antonio Spurs in 1996, has been head coach of his team longer. **Ruff** has 565 wins as head coach of the Sabres, second-most by a head coach with a single franchise, trailing only Al Arbour (740). **Ruff** has more wins than any other coach with his first NHL team.

2012-13 ROSTER NOTES

***13** were originally drafted by the Sabres -- five were first-round Buffalo selections (**Vanek**, 2003; **Stafford**, 2004; **Myers** and **Ennis**, 2008; **Grigorenko**, 2012)

***Six** were acquired in trades: **Hecht**, **Regehr**, **Ehrhoff**, **Hodgson**, **Sulzer**, **Ott**

***Three** were signed as free agents: **Leopold**, **Leino**, **Scott**

***One** was acquired from waivers: **Ellis**

***20** played in Buffalo at some point last season

The crowd of 19,994 was the largest regular season crowd in Flyers history. **Stars of the Game: 1 –James Neal; 2 –Claude Giroux; 3 –Marc-Andre Fleury.**

NOTES OF THE NIGHT

Scott Laughton made his NHL debut yesterday for the Flyers. It marks the second consecutive year the Flyers have carried their first-round draft pick from the previous season onto their opening day roster, after **Sean Couturier** did so last year. The last time that happened in consecutive seasons was more than 30 years ago, when **Behn Wilson** and **Danny Lucas** opened with the Flyers for the 1978-79 season and **Brian Propp** was on the opening roster in 1979-80. The Flyers selected Laughton in the first round (20th overall) of the 2012 NHL Entry Draft. He has 13 goals and 20 assists for 33 points in 32 games for Oshawa of the OHL this season.

The Flyers on Tuesday named **Claude Giroux** the 19th captain in franchise history. Giroux, 25 (1/12/1988), is entering his fifth full season with the Flyers, and also played two games during the 2007-08 season. He is coming off one of the best individual seasons for a Flyer in the last 15 years. Giroux posted 28 goals and 65 assists for 93 points last season, the most points by a Flyer since Eric Lindros had 93 points in 1998-99 and the most assists by a Flyer since Lindros posted 68 in 1995-96. It was the 9th-best regular season assist total in Flyers history. Giroux became just the fourth Flyer ever to record 50 or more assists in consecutive seasons, joining Bobby Clarke (8 seasons, 1972-1980), Brian Propp (3 seasons, 1983-86) and Mark Recchi (2 seasons twice). Giroux finished

third in the NHL in scoring and led the league in power play scoring with 38 points (6G, 32A). Giroux followed up with an equally stellar postseason, recording eight goals and nine assists for 17 points in 12 playoff games. Fourteen of those points came in the Eastern Conference Quarterfinals against Pittsburgh, which was the second-highest point total in a playoff series in franchise history. Giroux was selected by the Flyers in the first round (22nd overall) of the 2006 NHL Entry Draft. In 285 career games, Giroux has 78 goals and 165 assists for 243 points.

The Flyers have several new faces on their roster from a year ago –four players who are with the team for the first time (**Kurtis Foster**, **Scott Laughton**, **Luke Schenn** and **Bruno Gervais**) and two players that have returned after time away –**Michael Leighton**, who played last year with Adirondack, and **Ruslan Fedotenko**.

June 22 : Traded G **Sergei Bobrovsky** to the Columbus Blue Jackets for a 2nd round pick, a 4th round pick, and a 2013 4th round pick.

Ruslan Fedotenko played yesterday in first game in a Flyers uniform since April 26, 2002, when the Flyers had their 2002 playoff run ended in Game 5 of the Eastern Conference Quarterfinals vs. Ottawa. Fedotenko departed later that summer in a trade to Tampa Bay that landed the Flyers the Lightning's first-round draft pick in 2002, which was used to select Joni Pitkanen. Fedotenko has played 664 NHL games since then and has won two Stanley Cups, with Tampa (2004) and Pittsburgh (2009). That's the longest of any player besides Vlnny Prospal's 715 games between Orange and Black tours. The Flyers are glad he's back in orange and black –Fedotenko has scored more goals against the Flyers (16) than he has against any other NHL team, and has more points against them (28) than any other NHL team except Winnipeg/Atlanta (29).

Max Talbot and **Bruno Gervais** are playing together as pros for the first time, but it's certainly not the first time they've played together. The pair grew up together in Quebec and played on the same team when they were 11 years old, and have been best friends ever since. Gervais signed as a free agent with the Flyers last summer, while Talbot came the summer before. For the last two years, Talbot and Gervais have teamed up to host a charity golf tournament back home in Quebec, Omnium Gervais-Talbot (Gervais-Talbot Open).

Philadelphia Flyers: Head Coach and Player Bios

Head Coach: Peter Laviolette

Peter Laviolette is in his third season as the head coach of the Flyers. During the 2010-2011 season, Laviolette led the Flyers to a 47-23-12 regular season record, an Atlantic Division championship and their fourth consecutive appearance in the Stanley Cup Playoffs. The 47 wins were the most by a Flyers team in 25 years, since the 1985-86 team won 53 games.

Laviolette was named the 17th head coach in Flyers history on Dec. 4, 2009. Over the final 57 games of the season, Laviolette coached the Flyers to a 28-24-5 record. He then led the club on a remarkable playoff run, picking up series wins over New Jersey (4-1), Boston (4-3) and Montreal (4-2) on the way to the eighth Stanley Cup Final appearance in Flyers history.

Laviolette has also coached the New York Islanders and the Carolina Hurricanes, where he won a Stanley Cup in 2006. Additionally, he was the head coach of Team USA at the 2006 Olympics in Torino, and won the 1999 Calder Cup as head coach of the AHL's Providence Bruins.
