CONNECTIONS: Wild Assistant Coach **Bob Woods** served as an assistant coach for Buffalo during the 2016-17 season...LW **Tyler Ennis** was selected by the Sabres in the first round (26th overall) of the 2008 NHL Entry Draft and collected 236 points (97-139=236) in 419 contests with Buffalo before being acquired by the Wild (6/30/17)...LW **Marcus Foligno** is a Buffalo native who spent six seasons with the Sabres, tallying 116 points (49-67=116) and 334 PIM in 347 games (2011-17)...He was drafted by Buffalo in the fourth round (104th overall) of the 2009 NHL Entry Draft...RW **Chris Stewart** skated in 66 games with the Sabres in parts of two seasons (2013-15), totaling 25 points (11-14=25) and 69 PIM before being acquired by Minnesota (3/2/15)...Sabres Head Coach **Phil Housley** is a native of South Saint Paul...D **Justin Falk** was selected by the Wild in the fourth round (110th overall) of the 2007 NHL Entry Draft and collected 15 points (1-14=15) in 121 games in parts of five seasons with Minnesota (2009-13; 2014-15)...Larsson was drafted by Minnesota in the second round (56th overall) of the 2010 NHL Entry Draft, skating in one game with the Wild (2/17/13 vs. DET) before being acquired by the Sabres (4/3/13)...LW **Matt Moulson** tallied 13 points (6-7=13) in 20 games with the Wild (2013-14)...Okposo is from St. Paul and played one season at the University of Minnesota (2006-07)...RW **Jason Pominville** tallied 206 points (76-130=206) in 327 games in parts of five seasons with the Wild (2012-17)...Pouliot was selected fourth overall by the Wild in the 2005 NHL Entry Draft and appeared in 65 games with Minnesota (2006-09)...D **Marco Scandella** was selected by Minnesota in the

second round (55th overall) of the 2008 NHL Entry Draft and collected 89 points (27-62=89) in 373 contests during seven seasons with the Wild (2010-17)...D **Matt Tennyson** hails from Minneapolis.

NINE THINGS TO KNOW:

1. Minnesota has a four-game win streak in Buffalo since Oct. 14, 2013, outscoring the Sabres 15-3. Minnesota has an 8-2-0 record in Buffalo all-time, with a 32-16 goal advantage. Overall, the Wild has points in 10 of its last 13 games (8-3-2) against the Sabres since March 9, 2007, outscoring Buffalo, 43-25.

2. Devan Dubnyk has played three career games in Buffalo, starting with his Wild debut on Jan. 15, 2015. After being acquired by the Wild in a trade from Arizona, he flew on a cross-country, red-eye flight to join his new team in Buffalo and made 18 saves in a 7-0 victory – the largest margin of victory in franchise history – to become the first goalie in franchise history to earn a shutout victory in his Wild debut. He's 3-0-0 in his career in Buffalo, all with the Wild, stopping 86-of-88 shots for a 0.65 GAA, a .977 SV% and two shutouts. Since joining the Wild, the 31-year-old is 107-60-15 with a 2.21 GAA, a .924 SV% and 18 shutouts in 187 games – leading the NHL in games played and shutouts, ranking second in wins, T-2nd in GAA and third in SV% in that span amongst NHL goalies with at least 100 games played. Dubnyk has already matched his career high with two assists on the season (2014-15).

3. Nino Niederreiter set career highs Monday by stretching his goal streak to four games (4), PPG streak to three games (3) and point streak to six games (4-2=6). The 25-year-old has nine points (6-3=9) in 11 games since returning from injury on Oct. 31. He missed six games after suffering a high left ankle sprain on Oct. 12 at Chicago and agreed to a five-year contract on July 30. He is the only Switzerland-born player to net at least 20 goals in an NHL season – a feat he has accomplished in each of the last three seasons.

4. Mikael Granlund registered two goals and an assist Monday for a season-high three point and six shots. The 25-year-old has five helpers in a four-game assist and point streak (2-5=7) and 11 points (3-8=11) in the last 10 games. He missed five games with a groin injury this season but ranks second amongst Wild forwards in TOI/game (19:34), T-3rd on the team in assists and T-4th in points. Granlund agreed to a three-year contract on Aug. 1.

5. Eric Staal leads all Wild players with 44 points (15-29=44) in 45 career games against Buffalo. The 33-year-old has six points (2-4=6) in the last four games and 10 points (3-7=10) in the last eight games. He leads Minnesota with 18 points (7-11=18) in 20 games this season, also leading the team in shots (59) and shorthanded goals (2). Staal ranks T-1st with five multi-point games, and is second in goals and assists. He posted his 500th career NHL assist on Nov. 8, becoming the 13th active NHL player to hit the milestone.

6. Tyler Ennis and **Marcus Foligno** return to Buffalo Wednesday for their first career game against the Sabres, the team that selected both of them in the NHL Entry Draft. Both forwards were acquired on June 30 with a third-round selection in the 2018 NHL Entry Draft from Buffalo in exchange for forward Jason Pominville, defenseman Marco Scandella and a fourth-round selection in the 2018 NHL Entry Draft. Foligno leads Minnesota and is T-10th in the NHL with 61 hits in 19 games this season, posting seven points (3-4=7). He missed one game after suffering a facial fracture on Oct. 12 and agreed to a four-year contract with the Wild on Sept 14. Ennis registered his 100th career goal on Nov. 2 and has five points (3-2=5) with Minnesota. He grew up across the street from Wild defenseman **Jared Spurgeon** in Edmonton and the best friends were working out together this summer when Ennis received the call that he had been traded to Minnesota. Spurgeon tallied the primary assist on Ennis' first goal with the Wild.

7. Jared Spurgeon tallied an assist Monday and has five points (1-4=5) in the last four games. The 27-year-old defenseman has 15 points (3-12=15) in 20 games this season – ranking 10th amongst NHL defensemen in TOI/game (25:24), T-11th in assists and T-13th in points entering play Tuesday. The blueliner leads Minnesota in assists and power-play points (1-4=5), ranks second in blocked shots (41) and is third on the club in scoring.

8. Ryan Suter registered an assist, four shots, four blocked shots and two hits in a game-high 28:45 TOI Monday. The alternate captain has six points (2-4=6) in the last 10 games and ranks T-3rd on the Wild with nine assists and T-4th with 12 points this season. The 32-year-old leads the Wild and ranks third in the NHL in TOI/game (26:59), ranks third on the Wild with 40 blocked shots and fourth with 48 shots.

9. Jason Zucker saw his career-high, five-game goal streak (8) end Saturday – one game shy of the Wild franchise record. It also marked the end of his six-game point streak (8-1=9) – one game shy of his career high. The 25-year-old is T-1st in the NHL in third-period goals (8) and road goals (8), and T-3rd in GWG (4) – already setting a career high in GWG, and posting three in the last six games. In 20 games this season, he leads the Wild in goals (11) and GWG, ranks T-1st in multi-point games (5), and ranks second in points (16), T-2nd in plus/minus (+6) and third in shots (51). He set a franchise record by scoring six straight Wild goals, Nov. 8-11.

Minnesota Wild: Head Coach and Player Bios

Head Coach: Bruce Boudreau

Bruce Boudreau (boo-DROH) is in his second season as Minnesota Wild Head Coach after being named to the position on May 7, 2016. He's 467-225-91 (.654) in his 11th season as an NHL head coach and has led his team to eight division titles. Boudreau coached the Central Division at the 2017 NHL All-Star Game - the first time in team history and the first time in his career. He's the first coach in NHL history to lead 3 different teams to win streaks of 11+ games, the fastest coach in NHL history to reach the 400-win milestone (663 games, 3/5/16) and leads active coaches in point %. Boudreau went 208-104-40 (.647) with Anaheim (2011-16) and led the Ducks to four straight Pacific Division titles (2012-16). He went 201-88-40 (.672) with Washington, winning the Southeast Division four times (2007-11) and the 2008 Jack Adams Award. Boudreau tallied 70 pts (28-42=70) in 141 NHL games with Toronto and Chicago (1976-86).
